Thank you for using the Automotive Regulations Information Web Service. It has been confirmed that previous amendments were not reflected in the published texts of the following three regulations out of all 61 EEC Regulations available on the Automotive Regulations Information Web Service.

Below are the regulations in question and the details of content that was not reflected. Corrections are scheduled to be made according to the timelines indicated in the “Month of update” column.

Furthermore, it was found that certain updates were not reflected in the following EEC Regulations, even though these regulations have already been repealed.

In addition, some clerical errors and missing entries, such as dates of issue of the Official Journal, were identified in the table of Revision History of the EEC Regulations. While these issues do not result in any discrepancies with the current text of the laws and regulations, the unreflected items will be corrected and published separately on the website along with a list of corrigenda, to ensure the users can have full confidence when using our service.

In response to this incident, we are conducting a comprehensive review of other laws and regulations published on the Automotive Regulations Information Web Service as a precautionary measure. The status of each review is as follows:
